What to expect?

This module focuses on the more advanced and strategic topics within project management, not on the traditional functional aspects. A focus is put on the role project management plays within the organisation (both functional and strategic). Because more advanced and strategic topics will be addressed during this course, it is expected that participants have either attended a project management course (tools and techniques) or have some experience and/or exposure to projects and managing projects. The course will furthermore take a look at the role of the project leader within organisations to facilitate, not only successful projects, but to ensure successful organisations as a result of practising project management correctly and delivering projects successfully.

Minimum admission requirements

The applicant must at least hold an approved BTech, BEng, or a BSc degree from a South African university or university of technology. In cases where the applicant's prior learning makes him/her a suitable candidate for the short course, his/her prior learning will be considered by the course leader in the application process. In taking part in this course, it is expected of the student to either:

- Have prior experience in the field of Project Management, or
- Has successfully completed a course in Project Management

If either one of these requirements is not met, it is expected of the student to do some prior reading in preparation for this course. Contact the course facilitator for further details if this is the case.
